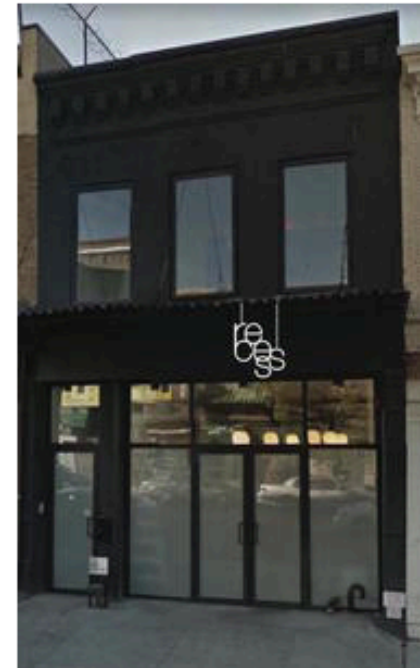

Recess Leaves Manhattan for Brooklyn

After eight years, the nonprofit project space Recess has moved from its Manhattan location in SoHo to Brooklyn, in the borough's Clinton Hill neighborhood. Located at 46 Washington Avenue, the new 5,280-square-foot gallery has three floors for workshops, special programming, administration, and artmaking. Recess's Assembly Program will move to the Clinton Hill building in 2019. Until then, it remains at 370 Schermerhorn Street in Brooklyn.
